**F.A. Gilfillan Memorial Award for
Distinguished Scholarship in Science**

Purpose	The purpose of the award is to recognize distinguished scholarship in science by honoring a faculty member in the College of Science whose scholarship and scientific accomplishments have extended over a substantial period of time. The award and public lecture represent a modest way of recognizing annually distinguished scholarship carried out by the College of Science faculty.
Criteria	Evidence is required of exceptional and sustained scholarly achievements and of wide general recognition by peers. A significant portion of the scholarly work must have been carried out at OSU.
Nominations	Anyone can submit nominations clearly identifying the intellectual substance and continuity of the nominee's achievements and the period over which they extend. The nominating letter (750 words or fewer) should indicate the breadth of scholarly activity of the candidate.
Supporting Materials	Other materials required to complete a file: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A biographical sketch (2 pages with content that supports award)2. Most significant publication list (20 or fewer)3. External support letters (1-2 letters from writers outside of OSU; 400 words or fewer)
Deadline	May 15
Selection	The College of Science Honors and Awards Committee will review the nominations and make recommendations to the Dean of Science.
Award	\$1,500 and a wall plaque
