**Loyd Carter Award
For
Outstanding and Inspirational Undergraduate Teaching**

Every year since 1946, the Loyd F. Carter Award is presented to two outstanding College of Science faculty members, one for undergraduate teaching and one for graduate teaching. The final selection is based solely on student nominations and voting.

Purpose	The purpose of the award is to encourage and recognize effective and inspirational teaching.
Criteria	All full-time staff members in the College of Science are eligible for consideration except the dean and department heads; the award may only be made once to the same person.
Nominations & Voting	Anonymous ballots are submitted by students by means of the website at http://www.science.oregonstate.edu/carterawards.html . (Note: Instructors are listed by the department to which they belong.) Electronic nominations of three instructors per student and voting typically occurs during the first two weeks of May each academic year.
Award	\$500 and a 4" x 6" plaque, presented publicly at the annual College of Science Faculty and Staff Awards day celebration in September which marks the beginning of each academic year in the college.
