**The Milton Harris Award  
in Basic Research**

---

<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the award is to recognize exceptional achievement in basic research by a member of the faculty in the College of Science. Special consideration is given to recent research that will have a significant impact on its field. The Award Symposium represents a modest way of recognizing annually the outstanding basic research carried out by a large number of the College's faculty.
<b>Criteria</b>	Evidence is required of achievement in basic research and of wide general recognition by peers. A significant portion of the scholarly work must have been carried out at OSU.
<b>Nominations</b>	Anyone can submit nominations in writing to the Dean of Science clearly identifying the intellectual substance and continuity of the nominee's achievements and the period over which they extend. The nominating letter should indicate the breadth of scholarly activity of the candidate.
<b>Supporting Materials</b>	Other materials required to complete a file: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A complete curriculum vitae.</li><li>2. Two or three letters from outside peers that provide evidence of the degree to which the candidate's scholarly achievements over basic research are regarded as truly distinguished or exceptional and the extent to which the candidate's achievements are recognized nationally and internationally. A maximum of two letters of similar content from peers at OSU may be included.</li></ol>
<b>Deadline</b>	April 15
<b>Selection</b>	A committee of previous winners will review the nominations and make recommendations to the Dean of Science.
<b>Award</b>	\$1000 plus 7.5" x 9.5" plaque
