**The Fred Horne Award  
For  
Excellence in Teaching Science**

---

<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the award is to recognize sustained excellence in teaching science by honoring a faculty member in the College of Science who has repeatedly demonstrated exceptional instructional qualities and has had a significant impact on students over a period of not less than five years.
<b>Criteria</b>	Evidence is required of exceptional and sustained instructional achievements and of high regard by students.
<b>Nominations</b>	Anyone can submit to the Dean of Science written nominations that clearly identify the quality and continuity of the nominee=s instructional achievements, and the period over which they extend. Previous nominations will be accepted for consideration for a 3-year period, with up-to-date material added by the deadline.
<b>Supporting Materials</b>	Other materials required to complete a file:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A complete current curriculum vitae, with special attention to instructional activities and achievements.</li><li>2. Two or three current letters from students and colleagues that provide evidence of the degree to which the candidate=s instructional achievements over a sustained period are regarded as truly exceptional and the extent to which the candidate has had an impact on student learning.</li></ol>
<b>Deadline</b>	May 15
<b>Selection</b>	A committee of past Horne Award winners will review the nominations and make recommendations to the Dean of Science.
<b>Award</b>	\$1500 plus 7.5" x 9.5" plaque
