**Thomas T. Sugihara  
Young Faculty Researcher Award**

---

<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the award is to recognize outstanding scholarship in science by honoring a young faculty member in the College of Science. The award is intended to recognize scientific accomplishments that have occurred here at OSU.
<b>Criteria</b>	Evidence is required of exceptional scholarly achievements and recognition by peers. This award is restricted to young faculty, which is defined as scientists who have received a Ph.D. within the last ten years.
<b>Nominations</b>	Anyone can submit nominations in writing to the Dean of Science clearly identifying the intellectual substance and continuity of the nominee's achievements and the period over which they extend. The nominating letter should indicate the breadth of scholarly activity of the candidate.
<b>Supporting Materials</b>	Other materials required to complete a file: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A complete curriculum vitae.</li><li>2. Two or three letters from outside peers that provide evidence of the degree to which the candidate's scholarly achievements over a sustained period are regarded as truly distinguished or exceptional and the extent to which the candidate's achievements are recognized nationally and internationally. A maximum of two letters of similar content from peers at OSU may be included.</li></ol>
<b>Deadline</b>	April 15
<b>Selection</b>	A committee of previous winners will review the nominations and make recommendations to the Dean of Science.
<b>Award</b>	\$1000 plus 7.5" x9.5" plaque
